#### MAIN TRACK AUTHORITY

RULE: **402**

TRAIN ORDERS BETWEEN M.P. 18.02 AND 22.69

YARD LIMITS 21.54 AND 22.69 (END OF TRACK)

---

#### SPEED REGULATIONS & RESTRICTIONS

MAXIMUM MAIN LINE SPEED: 20 mph

EXCEPT: EAST AND WEST BOUND TRAINS

OPERATING BETWEEN M.P. 18.29 AND 18.59

MAXIMUM SPEED: 5 mph (RESTRICTED SPEED)

MAXIMUM YARD LIMIT: 5 mph

#### SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. East bound passenger trains must contact designated Yard Master prior to entering B.C. Yard Limits. (During scheduled weekends only.)
  2. Proceed through Yucca St. crossing at Restricted Speed. Make sure gates are in down position.
  3. Derail at M.P. 21.75. Note: Derail may be left in the nonderailing position during train operations. However, it must be returned to the derailing position at the end of daily train movements.
  4. Trains may operate within B.C. Yard Limits without Train Orders.
  5. West Bound trains are not to proceed beyond posted Red Flag at M.P. 18.29. Note: Crossing at R.R. Pass is paved over.
  6. Train crews are to use extreme caution while proceeding through pedestrian/bicycle trail crossings at M.P. 19.36 and M.P. 18.59 (R.R. Pass). Warning devices shall be used in accordance with Rule #435 and #438.
  7. In accordance with FRA E.O. #26, cellular phones are prohibited and must be turned off and properly stored away at all times. Cellular phones are to be used *only in emergency situations*.

## **DEFINITIONS**

Restricted Speed: Movements made at  
restricted speed must not exceed 5 mph. Refer to Rule  
Book.

Employee: Anyone paid or unpaid.  
Employees of the NSRM and authorized volunteers.

Main Track: A track extending through yards  
and between station and stopping point upon which trains  
operate.

Siding: An auxiliary track connected to main  
track for meeting or passing trains.

Derail Device: A protective device that  
guides engines, cars or other on-track equipment off the  
rails.

Red Zone: When a crew member is on the  
ground and their duties require them to venture into  
hazardous areas in and around train.

Blue Flag Rule: This rule provides practical  
guidance to employees regarding blue flag use. Refer to  
Rule 431.
